How Our Programs Support Children

Power Readers

One-on-one mentoring

Weekly sessions with a mentor provide regular reading practice in a judgement-free setting rooted in the joy of reading, building both literacy and social-emotional skills.

The Book Project

Free-book distributions

Books distributed help children build home libraries and elevate underrepresented perspectives, helping all children see themselves and their dreams on the page.

StoryTime

Read aloud group activities

Read aloud events model positive reading behavior and use books to elevate themes important to student growth, like empathy, perseverance, and career exploration.
