

EVERYBODY WINS DC: POWER READERS

Power Readers is a one-on-one mentoring program that connects volunteers with elementary school students to read together for one hour a week during the school year. These supportive relationships help build academic and social-emotional skills, expand horizons, and foster a love of reading and learning. Be part of the Power Readers impact by volunteering as a mentor or creating a Power Readers workplace volunteer program with your company.



PROGRAM IMPACT

93% | SELF-CONFIDENCE

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Power Readers is offered in-person at 6 elementary schools across DC, MD, and VA.
- Mentors read with the same student each week and reading pairs can stay together year-after-year.
- Students and mentors can decide what books to read and how to share reading responsibilities.
- Power Readers sessions run October to May (excluding school breaks and holidays).
- Sessions are held during students' lunch/recess period so as not to disrupt classroom instruction.
- Mentors can join as individual volunteers or through a workplace/organizational partnership with EWDC.
- Students can join the program between October and December and usually complete 15-18 reading sessions per year.
- EWDC has staff at each partner school to facilitate program sessions and provide logistical support.
- Power Readers is free for families and schools.
- There are no lesson plans and no curriculum. Instead, Power Readers is about having fun through reading!

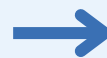

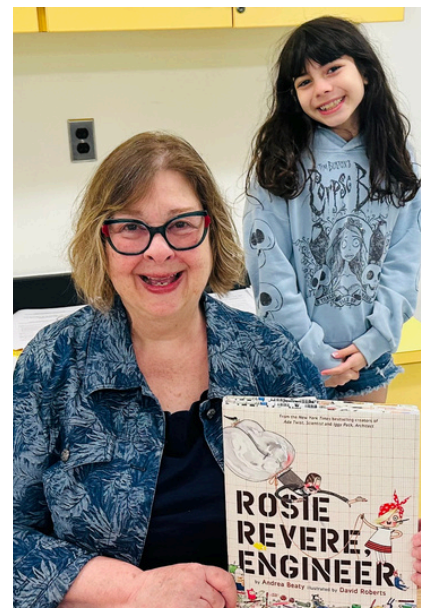
